

WHAT ARE ALL THESE MARKINGS ON MY PRE-PRINTED BALLOT?

Kentucky now requires a paper ballot for every voter. There are two ways in which to receive a paper ballot. There is the pre-printed ballots and the ballot created by the vote using the Express Vote Ballot Marker

If you use a pre-printed ballot to vote there will be specific information at the top that indicates which precinct and ballot options a voter will receive.

However, what does all these markings and information mean?

In a primary, the top of the ballot will indicate which parties are represented on the ballot. The choices are Republican, Democrat or Non-Partisan. The party affiliation is indicated by picture and party label.

The ballot will also indicate in the upper right hand corner the precinct code, precinct name and then the party affiliation as shown in the examples below. “REP” stands for Republican, “DEM” stands for Democrat and “NP” stands for Non-partisan.

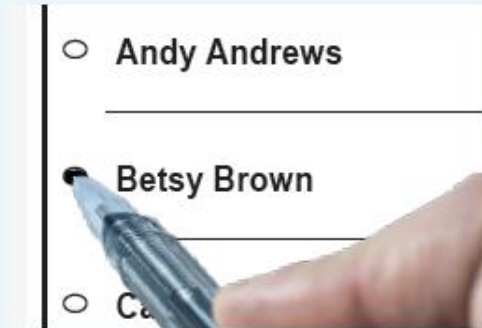

The voter reads the text to verify their selections.

Voter inserts the marked ballot into the DS200.

**STEP 4:
VOTER CASTS
THEIR MARKED
BALLOT**

The bar codes on the sides of the ballot are used to tabulate the voter's selections when it is scanned into the DS200.

The master barcode identifies the ballot style and contests to be tabulated.

DS200 reads a filled oval which corresponds to the grid coordinates of the candidate's name. These grid coordinates are the same coordinates used in the barcode. The DS200 reads the grid coordinates and tabulates accordingly.
