

WHAT ARE THESE MARKINGS ON THE EXPRESS VOTE BALLOT? (1-26-26)

If a voter uses the Express Vote, they will receive a blank activation card. The top of the activation card will have a bar code and information used to activate the specific ballot for the voter.


What do all these markings and information mean?

The bar code and number indicate the number of the ballot face.

In the example this is the 46th ballot face out of the 210 ballot faces that existed for the 2022 Primary.


The next set of information is:

- county name
- date and name of the election
- date of the election
- precinct code and ballot style.



In the example this is

Kenton County,
May 17, 2022, Primary Election,
5/17/2022
Precinct code B115 (B115 IND #).
Ballot Style: B115-REP (Rep ballot)





- In a Primary, all ballots are marked REP (Republican), DEM (Democrat) or NP (non-partisan).
- In a General Election, the precinct code is the same, but the ballot style includes the city and school board options. In the above example, the general election ballot for B115 would read B115-IND-KC2

After voting, the ballot will print from the Express Vote with additional bar codes at the top of the ballot.

The large barcode in the middle is the Master Barcode, which contains the ballot style and all the races that the voter will have on their ballot.



The series of bar codes are the voter's selections. Under the bar codes are the voter's selections in an easy-to-read list.
