

WHAT ARE THESE MARKINGS ON THE PRE-PRINTED BALLOT? (1-26-26)

If you use a pre-printed ballot to vote, there will be specific information that indicates which precinct and ballot options a voter will receive.

What do all these markings and information mean?

- In a primary, the top of the ballot will indicate party affiliation. The party affiliation is indicated by picture and either Republican “REP”; Democrat “DEM”; or Non-Partisan “NP”.
- In a General Election, the precinct code and is the same, but the ballot style will change to reflect the city and school board option on the ballot.

In the upper right-hand corner, the precinct code, precinct name and the ballot style.

Do not cross out or erase, or your vote may not count. If you make a mistake or a stray mark, ask for a new ballot from the poll workers.

STEP 5: TABULATE THE BALLOT

The master barcode identifies the ballot style and contests to be tabulated.

Column 9, Row 15, Sheet 1, Side 1 = 091511 = Betsy Brown

DS200 reads a filled oval which corresponds to the grid coordinates of the candidate's name. These grid coordinates are the same coordinates used in the barcode. The DS200 reads the grid coordinates and tabulates accordingly.
